**MINOR IN A SPECIFIC BUSINESS AREA – Requires 27 hours\***

18 of the 27 must be taken in residence at OSU.

6 of 9 hours\* (9 of 12 for MIS) for Specific Minor Area must be taken in residence at OSU

3 courses from: ACCT 2103, ACCT 2203, ECON 2103, ECON 2203.

3 courses from: LSB 3213, FIN 3113, MGMT 3013, MKTG 3213.

9 hours\* to meet the specific minor area requirements (See A through L).

All students must have as a prerequisite some basic computer course.

#### **Specific Minor Area Requirements**

- A. Accounting – ACCT 2103, 2203, and 9 hours of upper division accounting which must include ACCT 3103.
- B. Economics - ECON 2103, 2203, and 9 hours of upper division economics: must have a 2.0 in the 15 hours of economics required.
- C. Entrepreneurship & Business Development – 9 hours from MGMT 4113, 4610, 4623, 4663.
- D. Finance - 9 hours of upper division finance in addition to FIN 3113.
- E. Information Assurance – See separate declaration form.
- F. International Business – 9 hours from BADM 3713, LSB 4633, ECON 3613, FIN 4213, MGMT 4613, MGMT 4693, MKTG 4553, ACCT 4763.
- G. Management – MGMT 3013 and 9 hours from any upper division MGMT.
- H. Human Resource Management – MGMT 3013 and 9 hours from MGMT 3123, 3313, 4123, 4133, 4213, 4713, 4813.
- I. \*Management Information Systems – 12 hours which must include: MSIS 2203 and 3103; 3 hours from MSIS 3303 or ACCT 3603; 3 hours upper division MSIS (excluding 3223).
- J. Management Science & Computer Systems – MSIS 3233, 3303, 4263.
- K. Marketing – 9 hours of upper division marketing in addition to MKTG 3213.
- L. Sports Management – 9 hours from MGMT 3943, MKTG 3713, ECON 3723, MSIS 4943.

\*Exceptions: MIS minor requires 12 hours in Specific Minor Area; 30 total hours.
